The Grand Lodge Scholarship application portal is now open.

Students who wish to apply for a Grand Lodge scholarship can go to the Scholarship page on the Indiana Freemason website (<u>https://www.indianafreemasons.com/scholarship</u>) and click on the Apply (When Open) button.

Applicants will need three items from their sponsors: 1) their sponsor's last name, 2) their sponsor's birthdate, and 3) their sponsor's Lodge ID as it appears on his dues statement. This is done to validate that the sponsor is a member in good standing, meaning his dues are current. The applicant must also enter her/his cell phone number or email address to receive a validation code to proceed with the application. *The application portal will remain open until March 31, 2024.*
